As a condition of warranty, the accumulator/filter drier and orifice tube/TXV valve must be replaced. It is strongly recommended that the system be flushed and the condenser be replaced on vehicles newer than 2001.

**NOTE:** If the root cause of the failure is not diagnosed, a comeback is inevitable!
